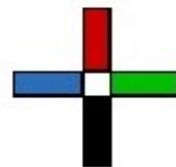

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST RICHARD OF CHICHESTER (c.1197-3rd April 1253 A.D.)

Born near Droitwich, Worcestershire, Richard was born into a gentry family but his parents died when he was young. Due to poverty, Richard worked on the family farm, but he desired to dedicate his life to study and the Church. He was eventually able to go to Oxford where he eventually became a teacher, and in his late 30s became chancellor. His old tutor St Edmund of Abingdon had become the Archbishop of Canterbury and called Richard to become chancellor of the diocese. Around 1240, he was ordained a priest and studied theology. In 1244, Richard was appointed Bishop of Chichester, but King Henry III objected and tried to block the appointment, even forbidding people to house or feed him. Richard was already very ascetical, being a vegetarian, and wearing a hair shirt. He was a great reformer of the clergy, removing the corrupt, but caring deeply for his priests. He died on 3rd April 1253, and his relics were moved to be enshrined on 16th June 1276.
