

SAINT OF THE WEEK

BLESSED JOHN OF FIESOLE (c.A.D.1386-18th February 1455)

He was born Guido di Pietro near Fiesole, Tuscany and trained as a painter and manuscript illustrator. In 1423, he joined the Dominican Order and adopted the name Fra Giovanni (Friar John). He is better known today as the master painter Fr Angelico (Angelic Friar). This is not only because of his superb skill, painting such masterpieces as *The Annunciation* in San Marco, Florence, but also because of his devotion in his painting and his life. For Friar John, painting was an act of prayer. He would say, 'He who illustrates the acts of Christ must stay with Christ.' He was also known to weep when painting the Crucifixion. He was known to have a good sense of humour and a love for the poor. Most of all, his life shows how human creativity should be united to devotion to God, becoming an aid to holiness by being united to prayer. He died in Rome in 1455. He is the patron saint of Catholic artists.
