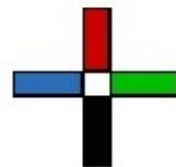

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST CAJETAN (1480–7th August 1547 A.D.)

Gaetano (*Cajetan* in English) dei Conti di Thiene was born in Vicenza in the Republic of Venice, Italy. He was a nobleman's son, but his father died when he was only two. He was a quiet and devout boy, encouraged by the example of his mother. He became a civil and church lawyer, leading to his appointment as a diplomat for Pope Julius II to Venice. When the Pope died, Cajetan retired from service, became a priest and returned to Vicenza. In 1522, he founded a hospital for people with incurable conditions, followed by another in Venice. Cajetan helped formed a group of men in Chieti (*Theate* in Latin) who would dedicate themselves to a monastic style of living whilst performing active works in the community. They became known as the Theatines. In 1527, while in Rome, Cajetan suffered torture during the Sack of Rome, but he fled to Venice. He continued his work, including founding a bank to support the poor. Eventually, he died on 7th August 1547 A.D.
