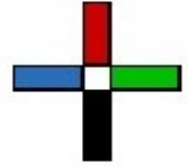

This week, we will celebrate the feast day of St Gerard Majella, the patron saint of expectant mothers. We pray for all who work in maternity units with pregnant women, that they may recognise that God is truly with us in each unborn child. Lord hear us.

STOP ASSISTED SUICIDE - FURTHER ACTION NEEDED!

Right to Life would also like to appeal for letters to be written to Peers in opposition to the assisted Suicide Bill. At Second Reading of the Leadbeater assisted suicide Bill in the House of Lords, a record number of Peers spoke. Of those who took a position, around two-thirds opposed the assisted suicide Bill. That is more than double the number who supported it. This momentum has been built by tens of thousands of people writing to Peers in opposition. See below to join the cause, even one letter written makes a difference.

Sending a physical letter carries particular weight with Members of the House of Lords. *Right To Life UK* has created a simple tool that generates personalised letters to Peers, each focused on a specific area of concern. You can then print them, or copy them out by hand, sign, and post them.

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST EDWARD THE CONFESSOR – c.1003 – 5th January 1066 A.D.

Edward was the son of King Aethelred the Unready and Emma of Normandy. His youth was disrupted by Danish invasions, resulting in years of dispute between Saxon and Danish rulers, leading him to flee to Normandy with his mother. Eventually, Edward was crowned King in 1042. He was known for his prayerful devotion and religious fervour, but he could also govern well, re-establishing the power of the monarch and so bringing peace to the Kingdom. In a time of frequent wars and invasions, Edward's rule was noted for over twenty years of peace. Whilst he was prone to losing his temper, St. Edward strove to rule with justice and charity. He was especially known for his works for the poor and the founding of Westminster Abbey, where his shrine remains. He was *the* patron saint of England until 1351.
