

### **STOP ASSISTED SUICIDE - FURTHER ACTION NEEDED!**



## SAINTS OF THE WEEK

### **ST PERPETUA & ST FELICITY (c.A.D.180—c.203)**

Unlike most early Christian martyrs, we know a lot about Sts. Perpetua & Felicity. This is because Perpetua wrote an account of her experience in prison which was finished by an eyewitness. Vibia Perpetua was a Roman noblewoman of Carthage (modern day Tunis) who was preparing to become a Christian when she was arrested in a local persecution against Christians. She was 22 and had a newborn baby, when she was baptised and sent to prison. With her was another newly-baptised pregnant slave woman called Felicitas. Perpetua describes her suffering but also the consolations that Jesus gave them. Felicity eventually gave birth and then she, Perpetua, and other new Christians were martyred for entertainment by being mauled by wild animals and having their throats cut. They are admired for their bravery and venerated for their triumph and witness. Their feast day is 7th March.
