



SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST THOMAS BECKET – 1119—29th December 1170 A.D.

Becket was born to a Norman merchant family in Cheapside, London. He received an education that enabled him hired as a clerk for the Archbishop of Canterbury. He became proficient in church and civil law and was made Archdeacon of Canterbury. In this position he came to attention of King Henry II whom he impressed by his efficiency and in 1155 he was appointed Lord Chancellor where his job was to oversee the king's tax revenue. In 1161, King Henry nominated Becket to be Archbishop of Canterbury. Around this time, Becket had a conversion experience and developed a deep ascetical lifestyle. His skills were now directed to the Church's mission which brought him into conflict with the king and in 1164, Becket fled to France. He returned in 1170 but the tensions continued, leading to his assassination by four knights on 29th December 1170 at Canterbury Cathedral as he was praying. Becket's murder shocked Europe and he was proclaimed a martyr.
