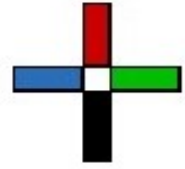

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST OLIVER PLUNKETT (c.1625-1st July 1681 A.D.)

Born to a minor branch of the Irish landed nobility, Oliver was brought up a devout Catholic. In 1647 he went to Rome to study for ordination to the priesthood. This was a time of great upheaval in Ireland as part of the Wars of the Three Kingdoms (of which the English Civil War was a part). He was ordained a priest in 1654, but Oliver Cromwell had conquered the Irish and Catholicism was being suppressed, so he couldn't return to Ireland. He stayed in Rome, becoming a Professor of Theology and an ambassador for the cause of Catholic Ireland until 1669. With Charles II on the throne, the suppression eased and Plunkett returned to Ireland as Archbishop of Armagh. He was an avid reformer and helped to reestablish the Irish Catholic communities. Anti-Catholic sentiment arose in the 1670s with the Popish Plot. Plunkett, though innocent, was arrested and taken to Westminster where he was tried and then executed at Tyburn on 1st July, 1681, the last British Catholic martyr.
