## SAINT OF THE WEEK

## ST LUCY OF SYRACUSE - c.283-304 A.D.

Lucia was born to a Roman noble family in Syracuse in Sicily. Lucia was a devout young girl who, without her mother knowing, consecrated herself to Jesus. From her love for Christ, she wanted to eventually distribute her wealth to the poor. Lucia's mother sought to betroth her to a local young noble, but when he discovered that she refused the marriage and was distributing her wealth, he reported her to the Roman Governor. This was during the Diocletian persecution, the last and most systematic attack on the Christians. After refusing to sacrifice to the Roman gods, she was executed by having her throat cut in the year 304 A.D. In the Middle Ages, the story emerged of her first having her eyes gouged out which were then miraculously restored when they buried her. This is probably a play on the fact that her name means 'light' in Latin, but that is why she is often depicted with a plate of eyes or a lamp, and is the patron saint of the blind.
