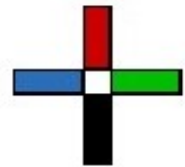

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST THEODORE OF CANTERBURY (c.602–19th September 690 A.D.)

Theodore was a Greek from Tarsus in Cilicia (modern-day Turkey), then part of the Byzantine Empire. When he was about 11, Tarsus was captured by the Persians. He was well-educated at the famous Christian school of Antioch, but around the age of 35 left Tarus and Syria due to the Muslim invasions. He settled in Constantinople, where he continued to study widely. In his late 50s, or early 60s, Theodore arrived in Rome where he was part of an Eastern-Rite monastery. There he became well-versed in Latin literature. At the age of 66, Theodore was appointed as Archbishop of Canterbury by Pope Vitalian. Arriving in England in 667, he worked hard to organise and unite Christian practise across the Anglo-Saxon kingdoms following the decisions made at the Synod of Whitby in 664. He brokered peace among warring kings, set up a school in Canterbury which led to a flourishing of learning in England, and taught sacred music. Theodore died, aged 88, on 19th September 690.
