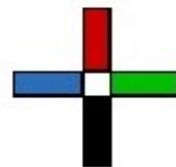

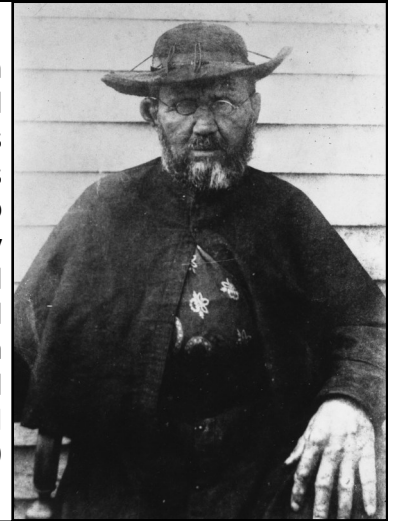
VOLUNTEERING FOR YOUTH MINISTRY IN THE DIOCESE OF PLYMOUTH

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST DAMIEN OF MOLOKAI (A.D. 1840-15th April 1889)

Jozef De Veuster was born in Tremelo, Belgium, the youngest of seven children. His upbringing was devout. Two of his sisters became nuns, and one of his brothers became a priest in the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. When Jozef was 18 he decided to join the same order as his brother, taking the name Damien. In 1864 he went as a missionary to Hawaii, where he arrived and was ordained a priest. Diseases and especially leprosy were a problem in Hawaii due to the lack of immunity. On the island of Molokai a leper colony was established to quarantine them, but it lacked proper government support. On 10th May 1873, Father Damien took up a volunteer post on Molokai, working tirelessly to improve the conditions and to establish a Christian community. In 1884 he realised that he had contracted leprosy yet continued to minister. He died on 15th April 1889 and his body was returned to Leuven, Belgium. His feast day is 10th May.
