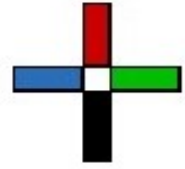

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY (c. early 500s-26th May 604 A.D.)

Augustine was the prior of St Andrew's Abbey in Rome. He was well-educated and a good administrator. In 595, Pope St Gregory chose Augustine to lead a mission to the Kingdom of Kent to promote the faith there in the court of King Aethelberht. Aethelberht's wife was a Frankish Christian princess, which indicated a level of toleration already present there, making it a good place to start. In 597 Augustine was ordained a bishop. However, it was a daunting task as the pagans had a fierce reputation, and even before arriving, the missionaries considered turning back. Encouraged by the Pope, they landed on the Isle of Thanet and were given permission to settle and preach in Canterbury. By 601, King Aethelberht was baptised and Augustine was promoted to Archbishop, giving him wider authority in England. He also established norms for Christianizing pre-existing customs to help conversions and established a monastery in Canterbury. Augustine died on 26th May 604.
