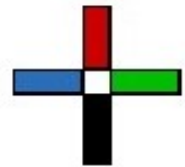

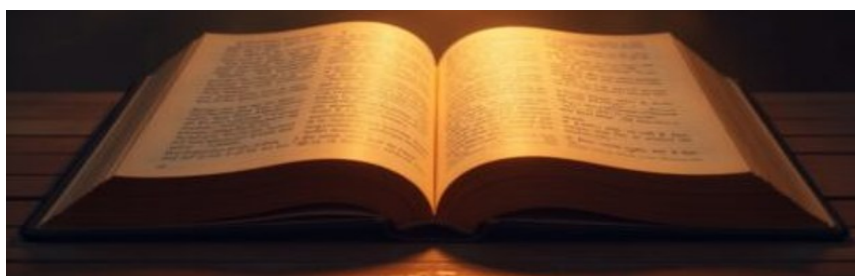
ONLINE CONTEMPLATIVE RETREAT—STEPPING INTO STILLNESS—22nd September

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST MONICA (c.332–387 A.D.)

Monica was born in Thagaste (Souk Ahras in modern Algeria) probably as an ethnic Berber, a North African native, she was a devout Christian. She married a Roman pagan, Patricius, with whom she had 3 children who survived infancy, Augustine, Navigius, and Perpetua. Patricius, irritated by Monica's faith refused baptism for the children, and he often committed adultery. Despite the values she had tried to teach her children, Monica was subject to much anxiety on account of Augustine who misspent his youth with different sects and sinful behaviours. She wept for him and prayed for the conversion of her family. Patricius eventually converted on his deathbed. Monica then followed Augustine to Rome and then to Milan, where she met St Ambrose who encouraged her. She witnessed the conversion of Augustine and journeyed back to Africa with him, but she died enroute and was buried in Ostia, in 387. Monica's remains now lie in San Agostino in Rome.
