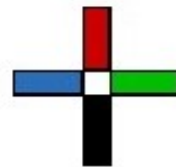

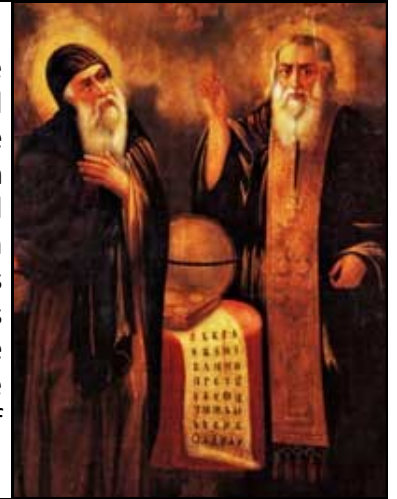

## SAINTS OF THE WEEK

### **STS CYRIL (c.A.D.826-869) & METHODIUS (c.A.D.815-885)**

Constatine and Michael were brothers from Thessalonica in the Byzantine Empire. They were well educated, with Constatine ordained a priest, and Michael became a monk, taking the name Methodius. In A.D.862 they were sent on a mission to Greater Moravia (centred on modern-day Czech Republic & Slovakia) to evangelise. It involved translating the Gospels and liturgical books into Old Slavonic, where they created an alphabet which eventually became called Cyrillic. They were successful in their endeavours because of these translations, but it brought friction with Latin missionaries from the West. To avoid trouble developing, they went to Rome to ask the Pope to judge the situation. There Constantine became a monk, taking the name Cyril. Cyril died in Rome in 869. Methodius was made Archbishop of Greater Moravia and continued the mission. He died in A.D.885.
