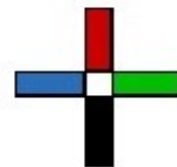

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST MARTIN OF TOURS – early 4th Century—8th November 397 A.D.

Born to a Roman military family, Martin grew up in northern Italy. At 10, and against the wishes of his parents, he became a Christian catechumen (a trainee Christian). At 18, he joined the Roman cavalry. While stationed in Gaul, Martin met a beggar. Seeing him, he cut his riding cloak in two and gave half to the beggar. That night he saw Jesus in a dream wearing the cloak and Martin decided to be baptised. His Christian faith caused tension with his military career and so eventually he left the army and became a monk with St Hilary of Poitiers. He was eventually made Bishop of Tours, where he dedicated his life to the Gospel and service of the poor. He died in 397 A.D. His cloak was kept in a reliquary called a *cappellanu* (after the Latin word for cloak) which is where we get the words, Chapel and Chaplain.
