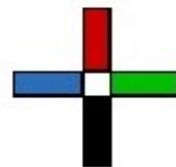

The Diocese of Plymouth is now taking applications from parents/guardians wishing to apply for grants for transport to a Catholic or Catholic/CofE joint school situated in the Diocese of Plymouth. SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST BONIFACE (c. 675-5th June 754 A.D.)

Winfred was born in Devon (later tradition says Crediton) in the late 7th Century. The earliest record shows he joined the monastery at Exeter which was located in front of where Exeter Cathedral now stands. He became a priest and teacher at Nursling Abbey, and was invited to become its abbot, but declined to become a missionary. He travelled to Frisia (modern-day Netherlands) to spread the Gospel in 716. It wasn't successful, but Winfred didn't give up and went to Rome to see the Pope. The Pope gave him the name Boniface and made him a missionary bishop of Germania. Boniface famously converted the locals of Fritzlar by chopping down the sacred oak of Donar. When the god didn't punish him, it convinced the people to adopt Christianity. Boniface used the wood to build a church. He founded many dioceses and continued to preach, but was martyred in Frisia on 5th June 754 and buried in Fulda. Boniface is known as the Apostle of the Germans.
