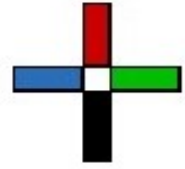

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### **ST JOHN FISHER (1469-22nd June 1535 A.D.)**

Born in Beverley, Yorkshire, John was only 8 when his father died. He showed talent at school and was able to go to Cambridge University around the age of 13, getting his Bachelors degree at 18, and his Masters at 21. In 1491 he was given a dispensation to be ordained a priest, soon becoming the chaplain to Margaret Beaufort, the mother of King Henry VII. Under his influence she founded St John's and Corpus Christi Colleges in Cambridge; later, as a Bishop, he consecrated St John's Chapel. He was well-respected and admired. The humanist Erasmus called him, '*the one man at this time who is incomparable for uprightness of life*'. In 1504, John was made Bishop of Rochester, the poorest diocese, which he served for 31 years. He was a staunch opponent of Martin Luther and his beliefs. When Henry VIII wanted to divorce Catherine of Aragon, and split with the Pope, John opposed him too. For this he was executed at the Tower of London on 22nd June 1535.
