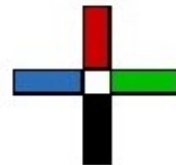

The assisted suicide Bill has failed to pass all stages in the House of Lords. This means that Kim Leadbeater's assisted suicide Bill has fallen and will not become law! This is a major milestone, but the battle is not over. Assisted suicide campaigners have said they are going to try to bring the Bill back in the next parliamentary session and use the Parliament Acts to bypass the Lords. 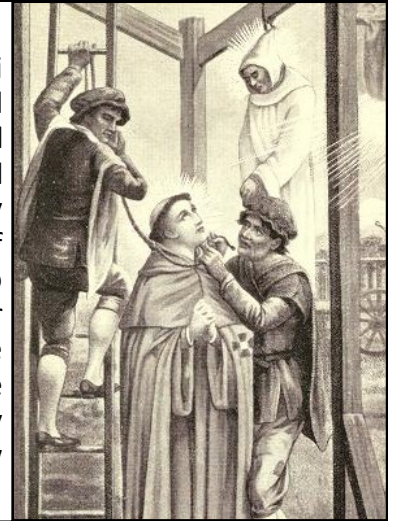

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST RICHARD REYNOLDS (c.A.D. 1492-4th May 1535)

Richard was born in Pinhoe, near Exeter. He was educated at Corpus Christi College, Cambridge, and in 1513 joined Syon Abbey, a Bridgettine dual monastery of men and women in Twickenham. He was well-respected and knew Latin, Greek, and Hebrew. He was also well-known as a holy spiritual director. In April 1535, amidst the Dissolution of the Monasteries by Henry VIII, Reynolds was arrested for treason and imprisoned in the Tower of London. He had been visited by Elizabeth Barton, a young woman who reported having visions, for spiritual direction and had even arranged for her to meet St Thomas More. She began making political prophecies against the King, which Reynolds, More and others distanced themselves from, but the association with her was enough, leading to his arrest. On the 4th May 1535, Reynolds was dragged through the streets of London to Tyburn (now Marble Arch), where he was hung, then disembowelled and beheaded.
