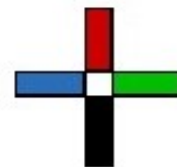

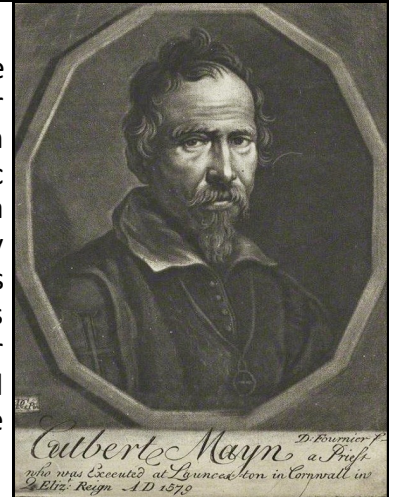
YOUNG WOMEN'S ADVENT RETREAT IN LYNTON—12-14th December 2025

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST CUTHBERT MAYNE – 1543—29th November 1577 A.D.

Born near Barnstaple, Cuthbert was baptised at St Peter's in Shirwell. The font is still in the church today. He was educated at Barnstaple Grammar School and Oxford University. While at Oxford he became Catholic, and in 1570 he escaped to Douai in the Spanish Netherlands. Ordained a Catholic priest in 1575, he returned to minister in England. Posing as the steward of a rich Cornish landowner, Francis Tregian, he began his secret priestly ministry in Cornwall. On 8 June 1577, Tregian's house was raided by the authorities and Cuthbert was arrested after finding Catholic devotional items. He was convicted of celebrating Mass, a crime of high treason. On 29th November 1577 in Launceston, St Cuthbert was martyred by being hung, drawn, and quartered. He was the first priest trained in seminary abroad to die for the faith, and he is the secondary patron saint of the Plymouth Diocese.
