THE CENTENARY OF THE FATIMA FIVE FIRST SATURDAYS' DEVOTION - 10th May 2025

The Pilgrim Virgin Statue and Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco are due to visit the **Cathedral Church of St Mary & St Boniface, Plymouth, on 10 May 2025**. This Visitation is a particular remembrance of the apparition to Sr Lucia, the oldest Fatima seer, which took place in December 1925 when she was a postulant with the Sisters of St Dorothy at Pontevedra in Spain.
