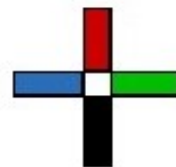

ONLINE CONTEMPLATIVE RETREAT—STEPPING INTO STILLNESS—22nd September

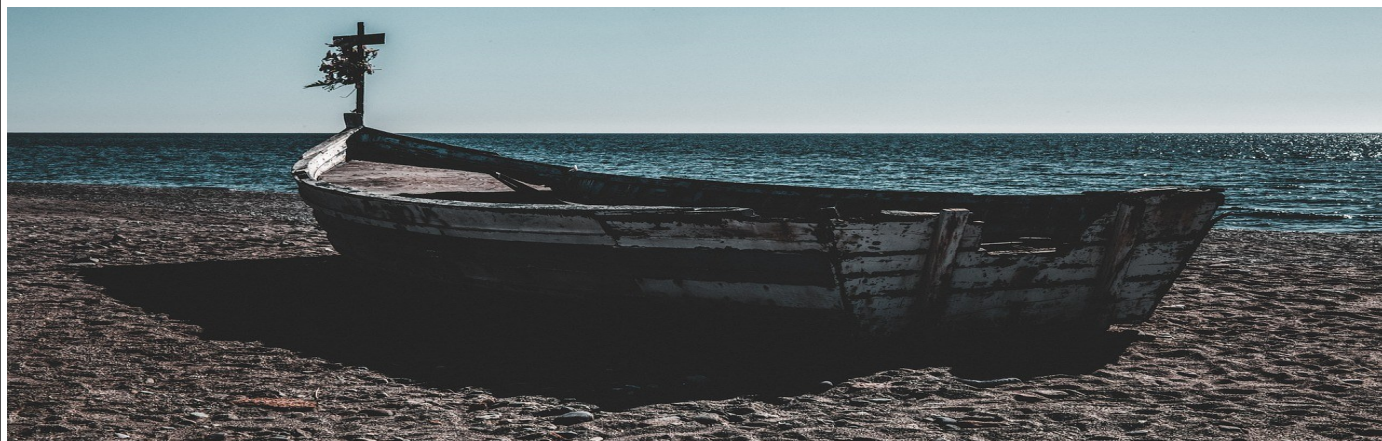

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST AIDAN OF LINDISFARNE (c.590–31st August 651 A.D.)

Born in Ireland, Aidan was a monk of Iona, the monastery founded by St Columba. In 616, Oswald of Northumbria had come to Iona during his exile. In 634, Oswald became king of Northumbria and began to encourage Christian missionaries to his kingdom. Due to his connections, these missionaries came from Iona, not Canterbury. The first bishop who went was considered harsh by the Northumbrians and his efforts bore little fruit, so they sent Aidan to replace him. In 635, he was made bishop and he set up his base on the island of Lindisfarne, near the royal stronghold of Bamburgh (not far from Berwick-upon-Tweed). Aidan walked around the diocese and impressed people by his politeness and simplicity, preaching the Gospel at the level the people could receive it. He founded religious houses, nurtured vocations (including future saints) and was generous with rich and poor alike. He is known as the Apostle of Northumbria. Aidan died on 31st August 651.
