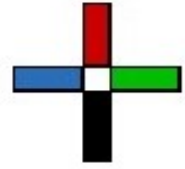

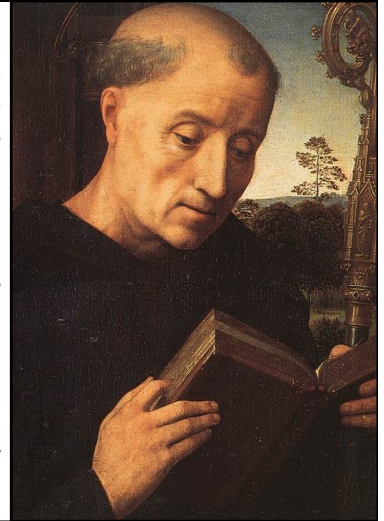

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### **ST BENEDICT OF NURSIA (c.480-21st March 547 A.D.)**

Benedict was the son of a Roman nobleman of Nursia (modern-day Norcia, Italy). Much of his life is known to us from Pope St Gregory the Great who knew some of Benedict's disciples. As a young man, Benedict went to Rome to study, but was disgusted by the immorality of urban life and moved to Affile, near Subiaco, east of Rome. Here, he encountered a monk, Romanus, who encouraged Benedict to give up his wealth, dedicate himself to God, and become a hermit. Wearing only a black habit, Benedict spent three years living alone in a cave near Subiaco, being supplied by Romanus. He grew in wisdom and prayer and his fame began to spread. With fame, also came envy, and he was the victim of plots against his reputation and life. Yet, Benedict overcame them all and developed a reputation as a miracle-worker, attracting disciples, who became the first Benedictines. He established many monasteries including Monte Cassino where he died on 21st March 547.
