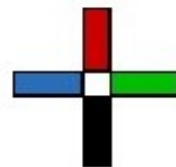

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST BERNARD OF CLAIRVAUX (c.1090–20th August 1153 A.D.)

Bernard was the son of a Burgundian noble, well-educated, especially in the art of rhetoric. At the age of about 23, he entered the new Abbey of Citeaux which had been founded to follow the Rule of St Benedict more literally. The order became known as the Cistercians. Bernard's example was so compelling that even his father joined. In 1126 he was sent to found a new abbey at a place Bernard called The Valley of Light, or Clairvaux. He lived an austere life which continued to attract followers and the abbey grew leading to the founding of other abbeys. He was a great mystic, somewhat sceptical of a too rationalistic and scholarly approach to religion, and a profoundly talented preacher. He had a great devotion to Our Lady, which spread rapidly due to his sermons. Bernard was also called on to reconcile Church disputes, including who was Pope. He preached in favour of the 2nd Crusade but was disappointed by the immorality of soldiers. He died on 20th August 1153.
