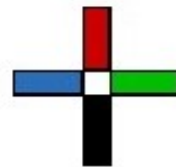

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### **ST AGNES OF ROME – c.291-21st January 304 A.D.**

Agnes was born to a noble Roman Christian family. She lived during the reign of the Emperor Diocletian, who systematically sought to destroy Christianity. He banned the scriptures, destroyed churches, and especially persecuted Christian nobles and priests. Agnes was very devout young girl who wanted to dedicate her life to Jesus. Like other Christian women, after refusing the advances of Roman men, she was reported to the authorities who demanded her to renounce her faith. Agnes, though only 12 or 13 years old, refused. For that she was put to death. Tradition states that she was dragged naked through the streets and then they attempted to burn her alive. When the flames didn't touch her, she was beheaded. Due to her innocence, her love of Jesus, the Lamb of God, and a play on the Latin 'Agnus' which means 'lamb', Agnes is often depicted holding a little lamb.
