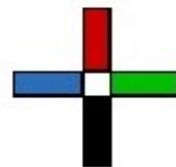

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### **ST ATHANASIUS OF ALEXANDRIA (c.A.D. 296-2nd May 373)**

Born to a relatively wealthy Greek Christian family of Alexandria, Egypt, a great centre of the Roman world with one of the most developed Christian communities in the world, despite persecutions. Athanasius was intelligent and became Bishop Alexander's secretary and deacon, joining him in the First Council of Nicaea to decide the question of whether the Father and the Son were of the same or a similar substance. This question was due to another Alexandrian, Arius, a charismatic priest who denied that the Father and the Son had the same nature. Athanasius combated this, formulating the earliest explanations of the doctrine of Trinity. In 328, Athanasius became Bishop of Alexandria. He spent over 17 years going in and out of exile as he refused to accommodate Arius's views, which ultimately led to the triumph of the Nicene Creed, that the Son is 'consubstantial with the Father' which we still proclaim at Mass. He died peacefully in 373.
