SAINT OF THE WEEK

POPE SAINT PIUS X - 2nd June 1835 - 20 August 1914

Giuseppe Sarto was an intelligent and devout son of a poor village postman near Venice. He was ordained a priest in 1858 and acquired a reputation for holiness through his preaching, care for the poor, the sick, and young children. He was made a bishop in 1884, and in 1893 he became the Patriarch of Venice. Cardinal Sarto worked hard to promote the Church's social teaching and to improve worship in his diocese. In 1903 he was elected as Pope, taking the name Pius X. He was a vigorous reformer, promoting liturgical reform, and lowering the age of First Holy Communion. He continued to live simply, reflecting his background, and even used the Apostolic Palace to house refugees. He strove for peace among nations, but died, saddened by the onset of the First World War, on 20th August 1914.
