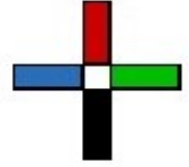

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST DUNSTAN OF CANTERBURY (c.A.D. 909-19th May 988)

Dunstan was born near Glastonbury around the beginning of the 10th Century. He studied at Glastonbury Abbey and developed a great skill as a craftsman and artist. The monk kneeling before Christ in the image is thought to be a possible self-portrait. He was also very learned and his renown attracted the attention of King Aethelstan. But envy caused him to be driven from the court, beaten, and thrown into a sewer. It led him to getting very ill, so he returned to Glastonbury and became a monk, working as a craftsman. When King Edmund succeeded the thrown, Dunstan was back in royal favour and became Abbot of Glastonbury, which he began to reform to the Rule of St Benedict, and founded a school. Dunstan's fortunes rose and fell with each successive monarch, including a period of exile, until in 959 he was appointed Archbishop of Canterbury. He oversaw reform in the Church in England, dying in 988 and was quickly proclaimed as a saint.
