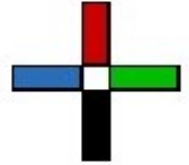

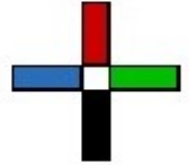

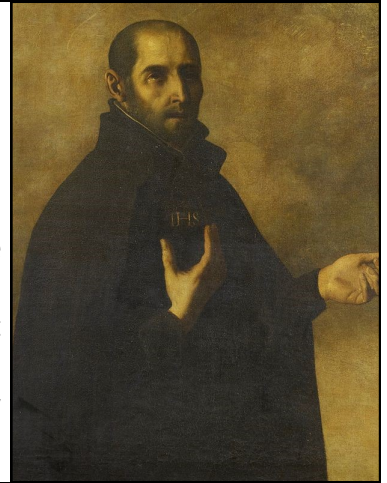

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

SAINT IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA - 23rd Oct 1491 - 31st July 1556

Ignatius was the son of a minor Spanish nobleman from the Basque country. As a youth he had the desire for fame. He took up fencing, dancing, gambling, and the pursuit of young ladies. He joined the military but at the age of 29 he was wounded by a cannonball. While convalescing, Ignatius underwent a religious conversion and sought to imitate the lives of the saints. He spent a year living in a cave and doing menial work for his upkeep. Eventually, moving to Paris to study theology and become a priest, he met Peter Faber and Francis Xavier, with whom he founded the Society of Jesus, a.k.a. the Jesuits. He encouraged the founding of schools and missionary preaching *Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam*, 'for the greater glory of God.'
