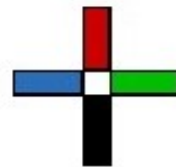

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST BERNADETTE SOUBIROUS (A.D. 1844-16th April 1879)

Bernadette, was the eldest child born to Francois and Louise Soubirous of Lourdes, France. Francois was a miller but the family had become very impoverished. Bernadette suffered from frequent illness including asthma which led to her growing to be quite short and missing a lot of school. By 1858, the family were living in a single-room basement of the abandoned local jail. On the 11th February 1858, Bernadette was out gathering wood with her sister when she encountered a vision of a beautiful small young lady in dazzling white. The visions reoccurred over many months, leading to local sensation and the discovery of healing spring of water. Eventually the lady introduced herself, saying, 'I am the Immaculate Conception'. Bernadette disliked all the attention and so joined the Sisters of Charity who ran the local school and moved to the motherhouse in Nevers. There she lived a holy and simple life, eventually dying of tuberculosis on 16th April 1879.
