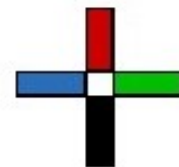

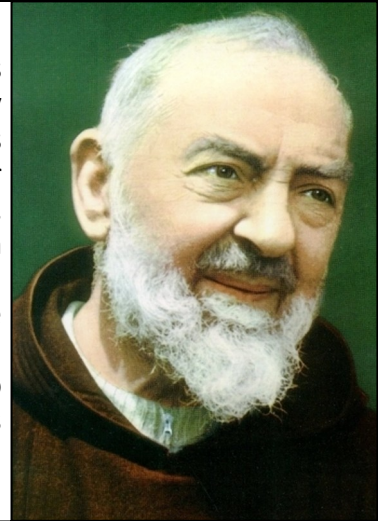

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST PIUS OF PIETRELCINA (c.1887–23rd September 1968 A.D.)

Francesco Forgione was born in Pietrelcina, in Campania, Italy. His parents were deeply religious peasant farmers, and by the age of five he already wanted to dedicate his life to God. As a boy, he experienced mystical visions and he was drawn to becoming a Franciscan Capuchin Friar. His father worked in the U.S. in order to pay for Francesco's studies so he could enter. In 1903, aged 15, he joined the Franciscans, taking the name Pio (Pius in English). He had poor health, experiencing fainting, migraines and vomiting, but at the same time he was seen to experience ecstasies and levitation. He was ordained a priest in 1910, and in 1916 Padre Pio entered the Friary in San Giovanni Rotondo. His reputation for sanctity grew and in 1918, he began to experience the stigmata, the wounds of Christ in his own body. He was known for miracles worked through him, but he also gave spiritual direction and even founded a hospital. He died on 23rd September 1968.
