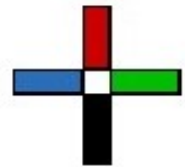

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST LAWRENCE (c.225–10th August 258 A.D.)

Lawrence is thought to be from in Huesca, in modern-day Spain, then part of the Roman Empire. As a young man he met Sixtus in Zaragoza and travelled with him to Rome. When Sixtus became Pope Sixtus II in 257, he ordained Lawrence a deacon and appointed him Archdeacon of Rome. This position was the most senior among the seven deacons of Rome and gave him responsibility for the treasury and distribution of alms to the poor. In August 258, the Emperor Valerian issued a decree that all Bishops, priests, and deacons should be executed and their property confiscated. Pope Sixtus II was captured and martyred. Next Lawrence was commanded to hand over the treasury. Given three days to gather the riches, he then gave away as much as possible to the poor. When he came to present the Church's wealth, he brought with him the poor, the crippled, and the blind, saying, 'Here are the Church's treasures.' Traditionally, he was grilled alive on 10th August 258.
