

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### **ST FRANCES OF ROME (A.D.1384—9th March 1440)**

Francesca Bussa de Leoni was a Roman noblewoman. As a girl she wanted to become a nun but her parents married her to the commander of the Papal troops. She became famous for her generosity to the poor. With her sister-in-law she travelled the streets of Rome caring for the sick and impoverished. Her generosity angered her father-in-law who was worried that all their supplies would be gone, but he was amazed that after Francesca prayed the stores would replenish. Her marriage was happy but it also had its sorrows, losing two children to plague, and becoming her husband's permanent carer after he was seriously wounded in a battle. Despite all this she turned part of her home into a hospital, founded a group of Christian women dedicated to charitable works, as well as a monastery! After her husband died she became the monastery's superior. She died in 1440. Her feast day is 9th March and her shrine is the Basilica of St Frances.
