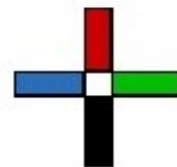

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST PETER CLAVER (1580–8th September 1654 A.D.)

Born near Barcelona, in Spain, Peter Claver joined the relatively new order of the Jesuits when he was only 20. After an insight from St Alphonsus Rodriguez, Peter was encouraged to seek ministry in the Spanish colonies. He was sent to the Spanish colonial Kingdom of New Granada (roughly modern Colombia) in 1615 where he was disturbed by the harsh treatment of African slaves that had been brought to Cartagena to work in the mines. He worked under Fr Alonso de Sandoval who taught him the Africans' languages and customs. Fr Peter would meet the slaves on the ships as they arrived, feeding, teaching, and nursing them. He would also journey to the plantations where there were also slaves, baptising and encouraging humane treatment. He would refuse the hospitality of the owners, instead choosing to live with the slaves. Fr Peter's efforts helped bring about some reform of the treatment and welfare of African slaves. He died on 8th September 1654.
