

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST WALBURGA (c.A.D.710—25th February 777)

Walburga was born in Devon to the saintly Richard the Pilgrim, a prominent nobleman. When he went on pilgrimage to the Holy Land, he left her in the care of the abbess of Wimborne. Unfortunately her father died in Lucca, Italy and she was brought up in the abbey, learning to read, copy manuscripts, and the *Opus Anglicanum*, a style of embroidery with jewels much in demand. Walburga spent 26 years at Wimborne, until in A.D. 737 her uncle, St Boniface, invited her and her two brothers to join his mission to the Germans. She evangelized mostly in what is now north Bavaria, eventually becoming Abbess of Heidenheim, south-west of Nuremburg. After her death, Walburga's remains were taken to Eichstätt and buried in a rocky niche. An oil began to exude from the rock which was said to have therapeutic properties conducive to healing. Her feast day is 25th February.
